I would love to be on the agenda to present to the board about how we can encourage our elementary schools to have a school garden program with an overview of potential funding sources, etc. In the same presentation, I would like to review The HealthierUS School Challenge: Smarter Lunchrooms (HUSC: SL), which is a voluntary certification initiative recognizing schools that have created healthier school environments through promotion of nutrition and physical activity. Schools can qualify to receive anywhere between \$500-\$2,000 depending on the extent of their initiatives. I can do these together, as they go hand in hand, under the title of "School Health and Wellness" or whatever title you suggest.
