An Ordinance of the City Commission of the City of Parkland, Florida, amending Chapter 12 Peddlers and Solicitors of the City of Parkland Code of Ordinances, amending Section 12-1 adding definitions of Charitable Organizations and Religious Institutions, amending Section 12-2 deleting the requirement that exempt entities must obtain an identification cards and adding a requirement that exempt entities are prohibited from soliciting or canvassing before 9:00 a.m. or after one half hour after sunset, deleting Section 12-3 other exemptions, creating Section 12-3 Purpose and Intent, creating Section 12-4 Uninvited Solicitation, amending Section 12-16 deleting 5:00 p.m. and adding one half hour after sunset; providing for codification; providing for conflict; providing for severability; and providing for an effective date.
