A. **RESOLUTION NO. 2017-54: ALLEGRO AT PARKLAND SOLAR LIGHTING VARIANCE (QUASI-JUDICIAL)**

A Resolution of the City Commission of the City of Parkland, Florida approving variance application Case number V17-002, submitted by Allegro at Parkland, LLC., for relief from Section 91-60 of the Land Development Code which requires all outdoor pole lighting installed on commercial properties to be one hundred percent solar powered lighting; and providing for an effective date.
