A Resolution of the City Commission of the City of Parkland, Florida, adopting and approving the Third Amended and Restated Interlocal Agreement for Public School Facility Planning; providing for execution; and providing for an effective date.

C. **ORDINANCE NO. 2017-14: YEAR-END BUDGET AMENDMENT (1ST READING)**

An Ordinance of the City Commission of the City of Parkland, Florida, amending Ordinance No. 2016-18, which ordinance did adopt the budget of the City of Parkland for Fiscal Year 2016/2017, and amending the City Budget thereby adopted to cause and reflect by an increase in the General Fund by \$4,525,000 and in the Capital Projects fund by \$3,000,000; the sources on the increased revenue/resources along with the destination of said expenditure appropriation of funds are as reflected below; providing for severability; providing for an effective date; providing for codification.

A. **RESOLUTION NO. 2017-85: PARKLAND CHILDREN'S ACADEMY EXPANSION PROJECT (QUASI-JUDICIAL)**

A Resolution of the City Commission of the City of Parkland, Florida, approving a Special Exception Use, Site Plan Amendment and Community Appearance Board applications for a ± 1,688 square foot child care center located in building "D" of the Parkland Town Center Shopping Center located on Parkside Drive; and providing for an effective date. Case numbers: SE17-002, SPA17-005 and CAB17-009.

B. **RESOLUTION NO. 2017-95: "PIGGYBACK CONTRACT" FOR CITY VEHICLE PURCHASES**

A Resolution of the City Commission of the City of Parkland, Florida, authorizing the piggyback of the Florida Sheriff's Association Contract FSA17-VEL25.0 and/or the National Joint Powers Alliance Contract # 120716-NAF for the purchase of four (4) Ford Escape SUVs, three (3) Ford F-150 pickup trucks, two (2) Ford F-250 pickup trucks and two (2) Nissan SUVs, authorizing expenditures over \$25,000, and approving the allowable funding in an amount not to exceed \$310,000 to Prestige Ford, Duval Ford, Terry Taylor's DeLand Nissan and/or Alan Jay Fleet Sales for these purchases; and providing for an effective date.

C. **ORDINANCE NO. 2017-13: APPROVING NEW COMMUNITY APPEARANCE BOARD REVIEW PROCEDURES (2ND READING)**

An Ordinance of the City Commission of the City of Parkland, Florida, amending Article 75, Sections 75-10, and 75-20, and creating a new section 75-15 of the Land Development Code, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Parkland, Florida, relating to Community Appearance review procedures; providing for a designated design review professional to review Community Appearance matters and make recommendations to the Community Appearance Board; providing for codification; providing for conflict; providing for severability; and providing for an effective date.

D. **ORDINANCE NO. 2017-11: PROHIBITING MEDICAL MARIJUANA DISPENSARIES (2ND READING)**

An Ordinance of the City Commission of the City of Parkland, Florida, amending Article 10 “Districts”, Division 1 “Generally” and Article 15 “Detailed Use Regulations”, Division 80 “Medical Marijuana Dispensaries” of the City Land Development Code to revise Definitions related to Medical Marijuana Uses and to prohibit Medical Marijuana Dispensaries; providing for codification, severability, conflicts and an effective date.
